Location: The match will be shot at the Monroe Gun Club (Directions attached), the Muskegon Rifle and Pistol Club (Directions attached), the Howell Gun Club (Directions attached), and the Jackson Sportsman's Club (Directions attached). The SEMNO High Masters Shooting Team will provide coordination for the matches, but each local club will be responsible for the conduct and safety of each competition.

Rules: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern.

Entries: Individuals: Entries in individual events should be made on the morning of the match.

Entries Close: The morning of each match.

FEES: Registration Fee: Price \$15.00 per match. Note: Collegiate and Junior Shooters may compete for \$8.00, but will receive awards as noted below.

- **Time of Firing:** *The Monroe, and Jackson ranges will be available starting at 8:00 AM on all of their match dates. The Howell Range will be available starting at 9:00 AM on all of their match dates. The Cadillac Range will be available starting at Noon to 3:00 PM on all of their match dates. For Cadillac dates contact Bob Lorenz: bob2484@acegroup.cc using his e-mail to verify dates before*

traveling. The Westland Range (Firing Line) will be available at 8:00 AM. Contact Mike Wesner (mike308@twmi.rr.com) before traveling due to potential cancelations. Juniors will be given preference at the Westland Range.

The matches are not squadded; you may begin the match at your convenience.

Classification: Persons who competed last year will be classified based upon their scores from last year. Averages will be calculated and the Metric prone classification averages used to determine classification. An additional Classification will be created if necessary to split the Master class to provide equity, if too many competitors become Masters. New unclassified competitors will have their classification calculated on the basis of their scores in Match 1 or Match 1A, and Match 4.

Rifle Allowed: Smallbore Rifle as defined by the NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules.

Course of Fire:

MATCH 2	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Metallic
MATCH 3	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Metallic Sights
MATCH 1a	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 2a	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 3a	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 4	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 5	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 6	60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
MATCH 7	The Snow Country English Match Aggregate, an aggregate of the highest four matches (two metallic sights, two any sights) Matches 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
MATCH 8	The Snow Country Any Sight English Match Aggregate, an aggregate of the four highest of Matches 1a, 2a, 3a, 4, 5, and 6, all fired with Any sights. (for those shooters who feel that they can no longer compete effectively with Metallic sights.)
Match 9	The Snow Country F-Class Aggregate. An Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 fired F-Class.

Any Sight Note: Matches 1a, 2a, and 3a may be fired with Any Sights. Match 8 will be the aggregate for those competitors using Any sights for the entire aggregate.

League Championship Shoot-off: The top ten (10) scoring competitors in the Snow Country English Match Aggregate (Match 7) will be invited to the Jackson Sportsman's Club in April 2011 for a shoot-off to decide the winner of the 2009-2010 Snow Country English Match Series. The course of fire will be:

60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Metallic Sights
60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights

The high scoring competitor will be the 2009-2010 Champion. All competitors qualifying will receive a commemorative item in honor of making "the Cut".

Additionally, the top two (2) Any sight shooters (providing five (5) or more Any Sight shooters compete) will be invited to decide the Any sight Snow Country Champion. The Course of fire will be:

60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights
60 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, Any Sights

Please note, a competitor may compete in both Match 7, and Match 8, providing he fires scores for matches 1, 1a, 2, 2a, 3, and 3a. If a competitor qualifies for both shoot-offs they will be allowed to choose

which of the two shoot-offs to compete in. However, we will require that the election is made at least one week prior to the shoot-off, to allow time to invite the next highest competitor in the other aggregate.

A competitor firing F-Class may only compete with other F-Class competitors in all fired matches for awards. Additionally, there will not be an F-Class shoot-off unless there are more than five (5) F-Class competitors in each match.

Note: Due to staffing of each match date, alternative times may be allowed for the completion of the required shots for range personnel.

Note: You do not need to fire on each date. You need to only complete all 360 shots (540 shots if competing in both Match 7 and Match 8) over the five (5) months.

Note: Matches may be fired in any order. However, you must ensure that the required type of sights used to fire the matches is correct for the match being fired.

Note: You may re-fire one match. The cost for the re-fire is the same as a regular match. You must specify which match you are re-firing prior to beginning the re-fire. The higher of the two scores will count for your aggregate.

Note: Each location is responsible for the safe operation of the matches held at their sites. The SEMNO High Masters takes no responsibility for the operation of any of the local matches. They are completely the responsibility of the local club running the match.

Note: The SEMNO High Masters reserves the right to disqualify scores from any location based upon evidence of improper scoring or activities not in compliance with the NRA rules for smallbore rifle competitions.

Categories and Classes: There will be separate categories for F-Class, Any sight rifles, AR-15 type rifles, and CMP sold rifles providing that there are at least five (5) entries in each category. All other rifles will be placed into the open category. An award for high Junior will be provided if we have five or more Juniors entered.

Award Disposition: There must be 5 or more entries in a class for one award, 10 or more for two awards, and 15 or more for three awards. If there are five (5) Junior and/or five (5) collegiate competitors in more than four of the fired matches an award for high Junior, and/or high collegiate will be provided.

Directions to Jackson from the Detroit Area

Take the I-94 exit, exit number 190A, towards CHICAGO/PORT HURON.

Merge onto I-94 W.

Take the I-94-BL exit, exit number 144, towards JACKSON.

Merge onto I-94 BL.

Turn right on

There are 0.35 miles (0.57 km) between the end of the directions and 500 Mantle

Directions to Monroe from Ann Arbor

Proceed south on US-23 to Planck Road

Exit onto Planck east bound about 10 miles

Turn left onto Yensch Road

Club is about ½ mile north on the right hand side.

Directions to Howell from the Detroit Area

Take I-96 West bound

Take CR-D19 exit number 137 towards Howell/Pinckney

Turn left onto CR-D19

Turn left onto Mason Road (first traffic light)

Bear left at the fork in the road onto Norton Road

Bear left at the next fork onto County Farm Road

Turn right onto Jewell Road

Club is just after the curve in the road.

Directions to the Muskegon Pistol and Rifle Club range:

Take I-96 West to US 31 South Grand Haven Exit (96 ends at 31S in Muskegon) Take US 31 S to Sternberg East (2nd exit south of 96), continue East on Sternberg through the traffic light to Quarterline Rd. (approx 1/4 mile. Quarterline is the first road to the left past the light. The road narrows from 4 lanes to two at Quarterline) Left (North) on Quarterline approx 1/4 mile to the range. White building on the Left: Muskegon Pistol and Rifle club.
