Rules: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern.

Entries: Individuals: Entries in individual events should be made on the morning of the match.

Entries Close: The morning of each match.

FEES: Registration Fee: Price \$15.00 per match. Note: Collegiate and Junior Shooters using metallic sights may compete for \$8.00 but will receive awards as noted below. Collegiate and Junior Shooters using Any Sights will compete as adults and be charged the \$15.00 fee.

- Time of Firing: The Monroe, and Jackson ranges will be available starting at 9:00 AM on all their match dates. The Howell Range will start at 8:00 AM. The Muskegon range will be available starting at 9:00 AM on all match dates. The Grand Rapids range will be open starting at 5:30 PM on all match dates. Blue Water Sportsman's Association will be available from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM on match dates.

Rifle Allowed: Smallbore Rifle as defined by the NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules.

League Championship Shoot-off: The top twelve (12) scoring competitors in the Snow Country English Match Aggregates (Match 7, and 14) will be invited to the Jackson Sportsman's Club in April for a shoot-off to decide the winner of the Snow Country English Match Series in each category. The course of fire will be:

120 shots for record, prone, slow-fire, 50 ft., USAS-50 Target, per category (F-Class, Metallic Sights, Any Sights)

The high scoring competitors will be the Snow Country Champions. All competitors qualifying will receive a commemorative item in honor of making "the Cut".

- Note: Due to staffing of each match date, alternative times may be allowed for the completion of the required shots for range personnel.
- Note: You do not need to fire on each date. You need to only complete all 240 shots over the five (5) months. You may compete in more than one category. If you qualify for the shoot-off in more than one category, you must choose which you will compete in one week before the shoot-off.
- Note: You may re-fire unlimited matches. The cost for the re-fire is the same as a regular match. You must specify which match you are re-firing prior to beginning the re-fire. The higher of the two scores will count for your aggregate.
- Note: Each location is responsible for the safe operation of the matches held at their sites. The SEMNO High Masters takes no responsibility for the operation of any of the local matches. They are completely the responsibility of the local club running the match.
- Note: The SEMNO High Masters reserves the right to disqualify scores from any location based upon evidence of improper scoring or activities not in compliance with the NRA rules for smallbore rifle competitions.

Award Disposition: There must be 5 or more entries in a class for one award, 10 or more for two awards, and 15 or more for three awards. If there are five (5) Junior and/or five (5) collegiate competitors in more than four of the fired matches an award for high Junior, and/or high collegiate will be provided.

Directions to Jackson from the Detroit Area

Take the I-94 exit, exit number 190A, towards CHICAGO/PORT HURON.

Merge onto I-94 W.

Take the I-94-BL exit, exit number 144, towards JACKSON.

Merge onto I-94 BL.

Turn right on

There are 0.35 miles (0.57 km) between the end of the directions and 500 Mantle

Directions to Monroe from Ann Arbor

Proceed south on US-23 to Planck Road
Exit onto Planck east bound about 10 miles
Turn left onto Yensch Road
Club is about ½ mile north on the right hand side.

Directions to the Muskegon Pistol and Rifle Club range:
Take I-96 West to US 31 South Grand Haven Exit (96 ends at 31S in Muskegon) Take US 31 S to Sternberg East (2nd exit south of 96), continue East on Sternberg through the traffic light to Quarterline Rd. (approx 1/4 mile. Quarterline is the first road to the left past the light. The road narrows from 4 lanes to two at Quarterline) Left (North) on Quarterline approx 1/4 mile to the range. White building on the Left: Muskegon Pistol and Rifle club.

Directions to the range Grand Rapids Rifle & Pistol Club:
Located at [1331 Nagel Ave SW, Wyoming, Michigan 49509](#). From the west, take I-196 to exit 72. Travel east on Chicago Dr SW / I-196 Business to Nagel Ave SW. Travel north on Nagel Ave SW. From the east, take US-131 to exit 83. Travel west on Hall St SW to Grandville Ave SW. Turn south on Grandville Ave SW. Grandville Ave SW turns into Chicago Dr SW. Travel to Nagel Ave SW. Turn north on Nagel Ave SW. The range is located in Marquette Park, directly across from Wyoming Dog Park and north of Kimball Stadium.

Directions to the Blue Water Sportsman's Association:
Located at 4866 Ravenswood Road, Kimball, Michigan. From the Detroit area take I-94 North (East) to Exit 366 (Marysville), turn right onto Gratiot Road, then left at the red light onto Range Road. Take Range road north to Ravenswood, turn left onto Ravenswood BWSA is just past I-94.
